

The Four Frames of Leadership

The Four Frames of Leadership, based on the classic work of Lee G. Bolman and Terrance E. Deal, is a method to reframe the work of organizations. The Four Frames is a useful framework to look at organizational challenges from multiple perspectives. It is a simple tool that can be used by managers, leaders, coaches, or anyone working within an organization. It provides a lens to reframe leadership challenges and to assist managers and leaders to approach challenges through different behavioral frameworks. Bolman and Deal's Four Frames consists of the Structural Framework, the Human Resource Framework, the Political Framework, and the



Symbolic Framework. This 90-minute GVHRA workshop will be an interactive session to introduce and use the four frames to consider approaches to organizational challenges.
